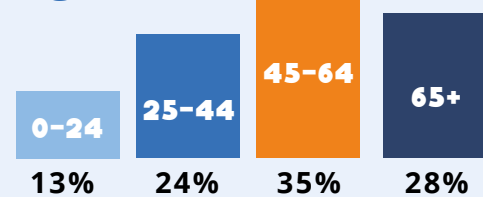
Consultation results

For the redevelopment of the Ostreme Centre to help it to continue to be at the heart of our community. The consultation ran for 4 weeks between November and December 2022.

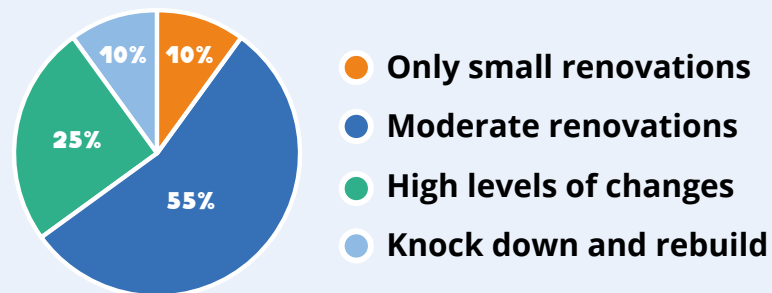
Who responded?
